

Preview of the LABoral programme for 2012

Its cross-cutting and integrated activity will be centred on sound, performance, audiovisual culture, digital design and fabrication and art and ecology

The LABoral programming for the year 2012 provides for an integrated and cross-cutting programme in which each activity forms part of a strategic area and performs a specific role given that all of the activities are inter-related. Exhibitions, professional workshops, -aimed at artists and creators-, workshops for the general public, an educational programme and interpreting and contextualising activities, as well as the production, research and resources areas of the Centre of Art and Industrial Creation, will be centred on five major thematic areas: sound, performance, audiovisual culture, digital design and fabrication -through fabLAB Asturias- and art and ecology –via ecoLAB—.

In the year which marks its fifth anniversary, LABoral will work to towards achieving greater involvement among visitors who are considered as the central focus and audience of all its activities, and will also act as a platform for the diffusion of today's art and the cultural expressions arising from new technologies. The Art Centre will pay special attention to the work of Asturian artists and will serve as a resource centre which seeks to support the creative process, establish synergies with industry and the private sector while strengthening its ties with the Asturian artistic community.

LABoral's Activities Director, Benjamin Weil, has emphasised the Art Centre's firm commitment to knowledge, education and greater accessibility to its contents in spite of the financial constraints imposed by the current economical situation. Additionally, he stresses the need to keep on weaving new alliances and the importance of further developing joint ventures and collaboration projects with other regional, national and international institutions throughout 2012. Examples of these include collaborations with La Casa Encendida, Madrid; MARCO-Museo de Arte Contemporáneo [Contemporary Art Museum] in Vigo; la Universidad Nacional de Colombia [National University of Colombia] - Museo de Arte, Bogotá [Art Museum of Bogota]; YCAM- The Yamaguchi Center for Arts and Media, to name but a few.

In line with these goals is the redesign and adaptation of different spaces at the Art Centre in order to make them more accessible, taking advantage of the full potential offered by the building, and facilitating better access to and understanding of the different proposals. Also, a very elaborate mediation strategy will be developed based on new features, such as the Interpretation Centre, the prototype of which can be seen in the *Experimental Station* exhibition, which opened at the end of October.

THE MAIN PROPOSALS FOR 2012

SOUND

02.03.2012 – 27.08.2012 Ryoji Ikeda. *datamatics*

• Programme: Exhibitions

Ryoji Ikeda, renowned Japanese composer and visual artist, focuses on the essential parts of sound and visual elements, such as light, by making use of both mathematical precision and mathematical aesthetics. Ikeda has built a reputation as being one of the few international creators who works convincingly with both visual and sound media, elaborately combining sound, visuals, materials, physical phenomena and mathematical concepts in immersive live performances and installations. Besides pure musical activity, Ikeda has been working on long-term projects. *datamatics* (2006-in process) is a project specifically adapted for the monumental character of the Projects Room at LABoral. It consists of a set of various forms transformed into moving images, sound and new media works which explore our capacity to perceive the invisible multi-substance of data that permeates our world.

Sound representations in contemporary creations

This international group exhibit intends to explore the synthesis between image and sound, the different graphical and physical representations of sound, and its evolution in the context of contemporary art. It charts a course of the most representative artists and pieces of the last decade, also focusing on "visual music" experiments by artists from the beginning of the last century such as Oskar Fischinger and James Whitney. *Visualizar el sonido* [Visualising Sound] originated in the idea of generating dialogue among all of the pieces that make up the exhibition, spanning a century of creation based on the same idea or concept: to dominate the wave, represent and tame it; the need to go beyond the place where our senses have brought us, which is, after all, the essence of all art. It seeks to show the broadest possible spectrum of the multiple representations of sound, investigating the sound dimension of the spaces we live in.

This work selected in the proposal call for Grants for Production 2011 by the Projects Office, *Danza infinita* [Infinite Dance] explores the ways in which biological sciences pursue the desire for immortality and life beyond death, revealed in an installation which includes the staging of a clinical trial and a dance rehearsal. This work intends to open up reflection on politics, body and property rights and advances in medical and biological research, at the same time as paying tribute to Henrietta Lacks, an Afro-American woman born in the United States, who before her death in 1951 had cells from her body removed without her consent for biomedical research.

Based on the study of the different technical, aesthetic and material possibilities, the Brazilian-Turkish artist duo develop a series of dynamic textile surfaces which make electromagnetic fields tangible. At LABoral they will continue with the work developed during their artist residency at La Gaîté Lyrique, Paris, in March of this year, to develop a large-scale interactive installation where 180 feathers will cover the Sala de Columnas [Hall of Columns], which will react to the electromagnetic waves of a mobile phone.

18.03.2011 – 09.01.2012 Anthony McCall. *Light Sculptures*

This monumental installation was specifically conceived for the Projects Room at the Art Centre for the occasion of the *Noches eléctricas* [Electric Nights] exhibition. Since the beginning of the 70s, Anthony McCall (United Kingdom, 1946) has been using film to create animated light sculptures that bring to the film media the aesthetic principles of minimalism: in an exhibition space saturated with smoke, the light beam creates an ethereal volume. His early work, produced with 16 mm film, consists of simple geometrical shapes that are stemming out of the form of a cone. Since the beginning of this century, McCall started to use digital tools to engineer more complex shapes. Also, the duration of his pieces have been lengthened, and the projections are now vertical –from the ceiling to the floor- in this way enhancing the architectural quality of his work.

SummerLAB_Showcase

Fourth encounter of free culture. Information Space in Process.

150 creators, artists and researchers from Spain and other countries, mainly working with open source applications, joined up this last August LABoral for the fourth edition of SummerLAB. SummerLAB Showcase exhibition, framed within Mediateca Expandida [Expanded Mediatheque], draws together and documents the research and creative processes that were carried out at this meeting. Conceived as work in process, the exhibit presents new ways of production in contemporary art, and through the videos, tutorials, photographs, documents and some of the devices used during last summer, it integrates and gives visibility to the four central activity areas of LABoral: education, research, production and exhibition.

Eduardo Guerra. *Hitos, ya nadie muere en casa* [Milestones. No-one Dies At Home Anymore]

This exhibition aims to reflect those places that die among themselves, the last things at home, yet in spite of this, it is not the end of anything. Pieces in which image and sound gel into a closed unit that contains a complex "landscape". The overall project is put into effect by ten "milestone sarcophagi", each containing an undetermined and unidentified place except for its photographic representation and a



sound track; combining image and sound in a non-cinematographic work aimed at transcending forms and formats. *Hitos, ya nadie muere en casa* has been produced by LABoral and was one of the proposals chosen as the winner of the proposal call by the "Oficina de Proyectos" [Projects Office], which entails the selection of two proposals by Asturian artists or those resident in Asturias, and another one for artists of any nationality.

This exhibition draws together the evolution and results from the work carried out at *ecoLAB*, a space for experimentation in the intersections between open electronics, art and ecology. Articulated as a multidisciplinary space and open to users, the working group constituted around the Project has been implementing different initiatives with the intention of operating as a meeting, research and participative point. From the monitoring and construction of sustainable infrastructures to sowing Works, and artistic interventions carried out in the described areas, the exhibition visualises the developed work processes and the results that have been obtained to date.








