

## LABORAL HOSTS A NEW SESSION OF THE YOUTH WORKSHOP VIAJANDO POR EL MUNDO THIS SATURDAY

The workshop *Viajando por el mundo (Travelling around the world)* continues this weekend at LABoral Centro de Arte y Creación Industrial. Intended for a young audience, participating children will be introduced to various nearby cultures through different artistic disciplines. The workshop began on the 19th of January and will continue on every Saturday, from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM, until March 8th. It is intended for children from 8 to 11 years of age, coordinated by Planet Idiomas. The session on Saturday, February 9, will deal with Sculpture in Italian. Carla Spaggiari will be the professor. It was her 20 years of experience in the field of child neuropsychiatry that interested her in the study and application of art therapy, including the use of artistic techniques and materials as a means of communication.

Professor: Marcia Das Mercedes Silva. Ever since she moved to Spain eight years ago she has been promoting the dissemination of Brazilian culture. Professor: Begoña Quirós has a Master's degree in textual interpretation from the Real Escuela Superior de Arte Dramático in Madrid and is a Senior audiovisual, radio and stage production technician. She has worked as an actress and as a producer in the theatre, film, television and the radio and is currently combining her teaching work at the Escuela Superior de Arte Dramático del Principado of Asturias with her work as an actress.

- Saturday, March 1. Architecture in American English.  
Professor: Kimberly Baldwin. She studied philosophy in San Francisco. She currently resides in Luanco and is a mother of two children. Her interest in projects related to art and culture stems from her desire to meet different kinds of people and to educate her children in an open and diverse society.
- Saturday, March 8. All the professors will close the workshop together and, along with the children, will evaluate their time spent at LABoral.
