

LABoral organises the Bloggers Conference which will bring over thirty young artists who distribute their work on the net to LABoral Centro de Arte

It will take place from November 12 to 13 and participants will create a macro-blog linking all their web pages.

LABoral announces its Interstellar Blogger's Conference for November 12 and 13 in which more than thirty young writers, photographers and video artists who make and distribute their work on the net gather together over a two day period in the art centre and create a macro-blog linking and inter-communicating all their web pages. During the course of the gathering, there will be a lecture on the phenomenon of autofiction on the internet and the French collective Konbini will present its experimental digital television channel.

This event on creation and web 2.0 social networks is part of the *LABmóvil* programme, a participation forum involving the production and exchange of audiovisual and digital content, financed by El Plan Avanza of the Ministry of Industry, Tourism and Commerce. In specific, it belongs to the Citizens' journalism section, set up by LABoral as a permanent web 2.0 and social networks experimental laboratory. These are spots where users can interact with each other through chat rooms, email, videoconferences, archive sharing, blogs, etc. Here, we hope to launch a new kind of communication based in content provided by citizens who are no longer limited to being passive consumers.

A presentation will be given the Conference's curator - authoress and contributor to the newspaper *Público*, Luna Miguel - to be followed by two days of dialogue on her experiences with ever more popular online communication tools. 52.2% of internet users consult blogs frequently in order to obtain information. This last February, the internet saw more than 25 million users, 13.1 million of whom went to blogs to read on current events presented from a personal point of view.

The programme also includes a Spoken Word duo with Eloy Fernández Porta and Agustín Fernández Mallo with literature readings accompanied by music and audiovisuals as well as the presentation of the experimental internet channel by the French collective Konbini. Several musical performances will also be held by CasiCasiotone, with visuals by artist Adrián Cuervo, and by Plataforma (FiumFoto, Ramón Prada, Komatsu) who will perform accompanied by Fuss!
