This week LABoral Centro de Arte y Creación Industrial will host a "LABshop's December Market" at which items designed by more than fifteen Asturian creators will be on sale. The market will open this upcoming Thursday, December 18th, remaining open until Saturday, December 20th, in the lobby of the art centre.

T-shirts, buttons, photos, post cards, purses, belts, undergarments, items for home decoration, jewelry, shoes and original dresses are only some of the unique artesanal objects by young designers working in the Principality of Asturias that the public will have the opportunity to acquire during these three days in the art centre. Further still, ten percent of the proceeds will be donated to the non-governmental organisation Amnesty International.

LABoral will also reduce the price of some items available for purchase in the LABshop. Together with some of the art centre's *merchandising*, visitors will find objects designed exclusively for sale there.

On December 18th, the market will remain open from 6:00 PM to 10:00 PM. On the 19th and the 20th, it will be open from 12:00 midday until 8:00 PM in the evening.

For entertainment, the Centro de Arte y Creación Industrial has arranged a live musical performance for each day of the market. On Thursday there will be performances from 8:00 to 10:00 PM by the Asturian group Galgo along with the music and visuals provided by EVSEPROLVISUALSUPPORT from Madrid. This concert is part of the monthly LABconciertos series organised by LABoral and, in this case, with the curatorship of Javier Bejarano. On Friday, the live performance will be given by Scattini at 6:00 PM. On Saturday, it will be the band Rhythm & Blues Los Corruptos that will be giving the musical performance.

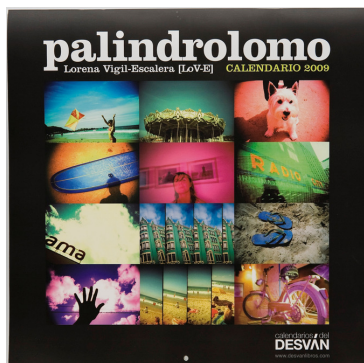

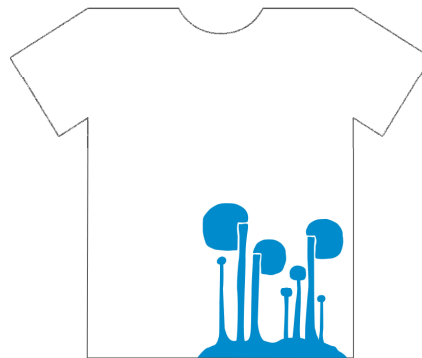
