

TOMORROW, THE DIRECTOR OF LABORAL WILL PARTICIPATE IN A DISCUSSION ON ART COLLECTING IN "ESPACIO ATLÁNTICO," VIGO'S CONTEMPORARY ART FAIR

Tomorrow, the Director of LABoral Centro de Arte y Creación Industrial, Rosina Gómez- Baeza, will participate in a discussion on "Coleccionismo. Otras visiones, nuevas apuestas" ["Art Collecting. Other perspectives, new ventures"] as part of "Espacio Atlántico", the Contemporary Art Fair being held in Vigo since Thursday, January 14, until Sunday, January 17.

Gómez-Baeza will share her experience and ideas on how art collecting in Spain has changed in recent years and how new technologies open up towards the future. At the discussion, to be held this Saturday, at 7:30 PM, at IFEVI, Vigo's Exhibition Centre, other participants will include: João Fernandes (Museo Serralves de Oporto), Jean-François Chougnet (Director of El Museo Berardo de Lisboa) and Marta García-Fajardo (Director of the art collection at La Fundación María José Jove in La Coruña).

"Espacio Atlántico", directed by Marta Scarpellini and with the artistic direction of David Barro, is considered to be the most important art fair on the north-east peninsula. The present edition has many new things to offer, including the creation of Vigo's Contemporary Art Museum: el MARCO. The Geneeal Programme of the Art Fair includes a total of 52 galleries that, this year, include an even greater international presence, as well as the most important galleries and institutions of Portugal.
